Welcome to the Music Room at Liverpool Philharmonic Hall

- We are a concert hall that has a wide range of music, comedy, film and family events.
- This is what the building looks like from the **outside at the front**.
- This is the main entrance of Liverpool Philharmonic Hall, on Hope Street.



The Music Room

- At the back of the building is the **Music Room.**
- This is where we host the Under-5s concerts. This door is opened from the inside by one of our stewards.





When you enter through the doors, you will meet one of our stewards who will ask for your ticket.

- Once you are through the doors, you will see the Music Room set up ready for the concert. There will be colourful lights and there may be some music playing before the concert.
- You can sit wherever you like and you can bring drinks and snacks with you.





Before the concert starts, you will see the orchestra getting ready. They might start playing their instruments to warm them up.



The concert will be presented by Claire Henry. Claire might be wearing a costume or carrying a prop.









- When everyone is ready, the orchestra will start to play. They will all play the same notes so they can make sure they are in tune.
- When they are doing this, the lights might change colour or brightness ready for the concert to start.
- Claire will introduce the concert before it starts. You may not be able to see her when she does this.

- During the concert, you are welcome to move around– the concerts are very informal and relaxed.
- At the end of the concert, Claire and the orchestra will say goodbye and then leave the stage.
- After the concert, there is no rush to leave, and you can use some of our facilities, such as the toilets, before you go.



We hope you enjoy your visit to us!

- If during the concert, you feel that you might need to take some time out, we do have some quieter spaces which you can visit at any time, including in the **Music Room Bar Area**.
- You can return to the main space if and when you feel ready.
- If you would like to bring **ear defenders**, or **small, quiet sensory items** you are very welcome to. We don't have any at Liverpool Philharmonic Hall that you can use.
